FAQ'S

I'm an interested applicant living outside Canada. How do I get an Endorsement Letter?

Before The Brooks Newell Region can issue letter of endorsements to candidates, they must receive a full-time/permanent position from an eligible employer who is based in the Brooks Newell Region/County of Newell.

I'm a candidate under work-permit and I am interested in participating in the Rural Renewal Stream. Can I get an endorsement letter?

Yes you can, but remember, it's your employer's responsibility to select their best candidate and request an endorsement letter on their candidate's behalf.

I'm a local employer who is experiencing difficulties in filling labour vacancies. Can I participate under the Rural Renewal Stream?

Is the program only for candidates who are already living in Canada?

The Rural Renewal Program is open for candidates that are already living in Canada with a valid status as well as prospective candidates who live overseas.
